

Siting norms for Hot Mix Plant (Notification dated 31st July, 2001)

1. Minimum distance from boundry of Municipal limit/urbanisable zone of draft development plan/development plan 2 KM
2. Minimum distance from village phrni (Lal dora where there is no phirni) 1 KM
3. Minimum distance from nearest National Highway 1.5 KM
4. Minimum distance from nearest state Highway 1 KM
5. Minimum distance from nearest major District Road and other roads 500 m
6. Minimum distance from sensitive places Like Hospitals, Tourist sport, Lakes, national Monuments and bird Sanctuaries 2 KM
7. Minimum land required 2 Acre
8. Green belt of atleast 30 meter wide between two plants
9. Emission standard 150 ug/m³
10. APCM required : Reverse Air cleaning or dry dust collector (multi-cyclone with multiple wet scrubber).

Note:

The siting criteria not applicable for Hot Mix Plants established in the zone i.e. ferozpur kalan in district Faridabad and Silana in District Jhajjar.

These siting criteria shall not be applicable for HMP directed to be shifted under the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India

Order

No, S.O. 78/PAI/49/S.3/92- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the East Punjab Control of Bricks Supplies Act, 1949 and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Haryana hereby makes the following order further to amend the Haryana Control of Bricks Supplies Order, 1972, namely:-

1. The Order may be called the Haryana Control of Bricks Supplies (First Amendment) Order, 1992.
2. In the Haryana Control of Bricks Supplies Order, 1972, in clause 4, for sub- clause (iii), the following sub- clause shall be substituted, namely:-
3. The District Magistrate may grant or renew or refuse to grant or renew a license for reasons to be recorded in writing, provided the site of the kiln is situated as distances not less than these indicated below:-

(a)	By-pass from road	100 meters	Distance is to measured the nearest edge of the reservation
(b)	Scheduled Road	30 meters	Ditto
(c)	Other District Paeca Road	30 meters	Ditto
(d)	Village link road	30 meters	Ditto
(e)	Municipal limit For "A" class Cities	3 kilometers	Distance is to measured Class as the crowdies from the nearest Cited portion of the Municipal limits
	Municipal Limit For "B" class Cities	2 Kilometres	Ditto
	Municipal limit	1 Kilometres	Ditto

Explanation – (1) Garden (A Garden shall be considered as such only if it has an area of atleast one acre and having 35 fruit trees of the age of minimum one year and in support of this entries should exist in the revenue records).

(2) Nursery/ Forest Nursery (A Nursery/ Forest Nursery would be considered as such only, if it has been area of one kanal where unit or other plants are reared for sale or plantation).

(k) Nursery/ Forest Two Kilometers Reserve forest
declared by the
Government

Note: Except in case of Garden nursery/Forest nursery and Forest, the distance should be reckoned with reference to other edge of the site of the kiln. In their case it should be measured from the nearest outer edge of the vesal of the kiln.

Provided that the District Magistrate may renew a licence of such brick kiln is already functioning of operation at a distance less than these specified above.

Provided further that before suspending or revoking a licence a reasonable opportunity of being heard shall be informed to the person concerned

Provided further that no licence shall be granted unless the person making as application for the grant of licence undertakes to procure clay/ brick earth for the manufacture of bricks from the village pond. The District Magistrate may, however, dispense with this undertaking if he is satisfied that either there is o pond in the area nearby where the brick kiln is proposed to be setup or clay from such pond is not suitable for manufacture of brick.

Explanation- Scheduled Road shall the same meaning as is assigned to it in the Punjab. Scheduled Roads and Controlled Areas Restriction of Unregulated Development Act, 1943”.
