Sub :Directions of CPCB on Steps to be taken in view of the deterioration of Air Quality in Delhi - NCR - Reg.


Ref :Order No.A-19014/45/Comm.AQM-NCRAA/2020-21 dated 11.11.2020 of CPCB.

Please refer to the above subject and cited reference through which the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), giving reference of the decision of Commission on Air Quality Management in NCR and Adjoining Areas, in its meeting held on 10.11.2020, to invoke the Graded Response Action Plan (GRAP) in view of the deteriorating air quality in NCR, till a mechanism is set by the Commission, and the level of pollutants in Delhi NCR during the past few days, has concluded that the Air Quality Index shall remain in Very Poor category and may result in Severe Category in the coming days (copy of order of CPCB enclosed along for reference).

Accordingly, considering the above and likely increase in activities during festive seasons, the following actions have been directed by CPCB to be ensured by all the implementing agencies / Departments/ Officers, with immediate effect.

- a) Hot mix plants and stone crushers shall remain closed all the time till 17.11.2020
- b) Frequency of mechanized cleaning of roads and water sprinkling to be increased, particularly on the road stretches with high dust generation potential.
- c) It shall be ensured that guidelines / SOPs for dust mitigation at construction sites are strictly adhered to. In case of violations, strict action should be taken against the violators like imposition of penalty / temporary stoppage of construction activities, etc.
- d) Immediate stringent actions to be taken for curbing stubble burning and any of the bio mass burning activity should also be strictly checked and prevented.
- e) Directions of Hon'ble Courts and NGT regarding banning of sale and use of fire crackers should be strictly complied with, by all agencies concerned.

The above directions of CPCB may be taken up on **Top Priority**, and action taken in this regard be sent to the Board for compilation.
